## Year 6 Spring Term 2 Newsletter

During Spring Term 2, in English, Year 6 pupils will continue to explore Shakespeare's, Macbeth. In addition to this, pupils will be using extracts from the novel, 'Oh Maya Gods' to help them to write for a range of purposes. In maths, pupils will continue to refine their knowledge and skills with the four operations, fractions, decimals and percentages, in addition to completing tasks relating to ratio, proportion, statistics and geometry. Their history topic continues to be the Mayan civilisation. The Science topic for Spring 2 is 'Healthy Bodies'. In Art, pupils will explore surface and colour. Year 6 will complete an exciting new computing unit, in which they will learn how to use programming to create music. In RE, they will explore why Good Friday and Easter Day are the most important days for Christians. Pupils will continue their weekly PE lessons with Coach John Spence and weekly swimming lessons at Mill House Leisure Centre (please see below for kit requirements).

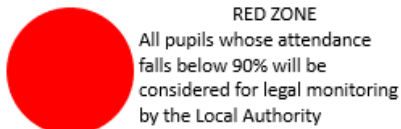
### SATs Booster Classes

## TRAFFIC LIGHT ZONE



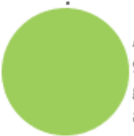
#### RED ZONE

All pupils whose attendance falls below 90% will be considered for legal monitoring by the Local Authority



#### AMBER ZONE

Those pupils who have fallen between 91%-96% are in the Amber Zone. Those in this zone are automatically monitored by school.



#### GREEN ZONE

All pupils whose attendance is 97% and above are part of the green zone. As Green a pupil you are more likely to achieve.

### Punctuality

**Pupils Late for school:** Pupils who are late for school are missing the important start of their lesson and their entry into the classrooms late, is also causing disruption to other pupils in their class. ## School Uniform

Please ensure that your child wears full school uniform each day for school.

Our school uniform consists of:

- Grey trousers or skirt;
- White polo shirt;
- Red school jumper/cardigan;
- **Black shoes**



**We expect all pupils to wear black shoes for school. Please ensure your child does not wear white or brightly coloured trainers to school as this is not permitted.**

## Home Learning and Reading at Home

Home learning helps pupils to embed the knowledge they have learnt each week. We would be grateful if you could support and encourage your child to return their weekly homework.

Homework will be set on a **Friday** and must be completed and returned on a **Thursday**.

For children unable to access the internet, paper copies are always available - parents must inform class teacher if these are required.

### **Homework activities:**

- 15 minute daily arithmetic practice using Maths Bot (please see previous letter with your child's log in details)
- 15 minutes per day home reading
- Your child may be provided with additional homework, where necessary.

### **Reading at home**

Reading records are sent home on a Friday and must be returned to school Thursday of the following week. Your child is encouraged to read at least three times a week with an adult, who should then comment and sign the reading record on each of the three occasions.

Children who read at least three times per week will be awarded a Golden Ticket. Every time your child earns a Golden Ticket, their name is entered into a monthly draw to win a new reading book and certificate.

Please encourage your child to read as regularly as possible.

## PE

Your child's PE day for **Spring 2** is **Thursday**.

All pupils must wear full school uniform but need to bring a full swimming kit for their afternoon lesson. This consists of:

- Swimming costume/trunks (not swimming shorts)
- Towel
- Swimming cap
