This term our theme within the Early Years is Are Heroes Real?

In Nursery our topic is Caped Crusaders

Within this topic children will learn about Superheroes both imaginary and real. Through key texts they will develop an understanding of what makes a Superhero and the characteristics, skills and attributes it takes to be a real superhero in their everyday life. The children will explore the imaginary world of Superheroes and create their own Superhero persona, powers, costumes and stories. They will then apply this knowledge to real Superheroes in their everyday lives through visits from and to 'Local Heroes' in their community. The children will learn about the Superpower of kindness and how just like Superheroes they can make the world a better place by looking after, taking care of, helping and being kind to others. Through meeting and talking to real life local heroes such as Police Officers, Firefighters, Nurses and exploring the qualities relating to those heroes we aim to give the children aspirations to be a Superhero today and each day in their future lives.

Ideas to support your child's learning through this topic:

Communication and Language

- Talk about local heroes in the community and how they help us

Physical Development

- Develop your child's independence when putting on their own coat and fastening the zip/buttons
- Practise writing your child's name with them

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Talk about qualities that Superheroes have such as kind, brave, fearless

Literacy

- Share stories relating to our new topic – see the attached list for links and titles
- Read stories with your child and visit the central library for story time on Mondays at 10am and 1.30pm

Maths

- Draw your own Superhero world – how many Superheroes will be in each building – 1, 2 or 3?
- Make a repeating pattern using Spring flowers or Superheroes
