Attendance and Punctuality

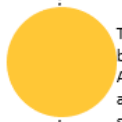
Attendance

TRAFFIC LIGHT ZONE



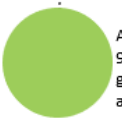
RED ZONE

All pupils whose attendance falls below 90% will be considered for legal monitoring by the Local Authority



AMBER ZONE

Those pupils who have fallen between 91%-96% are in the Amber Zone. Those in this zone are automatically monitored by school.



GREEN ZONE

All pupils whose attendance is 97% and above are part of the green zone. As Green a pupil you are more likely to achieve.

Punctuality

Pupils Late for school: Pupils who are late for school are missing the important start of their lesson and their entry into the classrooms late, is also causing disruption to other pupils in their class. Please make sure your child is in school on time each day. Your child must be in school for 8.45am.

Keeping You Informed

Class Dojo: Please ensure that you are signed up to Class Dojo to receive regular school and class updates. If you wish to contact a member of staff, you should do by clicking on the chat link and selecting the name of the staff member required. Phone calls can be arranged to speak to staff members, again this can be done so by contacting that staff member via Class Dojo.

School Uniform

Please ensure that your child wears full school uniform each day for school.

Our School uniform consists of:

- Grey trousers or skirt;
- White polo shirt;
- Red school jumper/cardigan;
- **Black shoes**



We expect all pupils to wear **black shoes for school**. Please ensure your child does not wear white or brightly coloured trainers to school as this is not permitted.

Now the weather is getting warmer, please make sure you child comes to school wearing suncream and a hat.

Home Learning and Reading at Home

Home learning helps pupils to embed the knowledge they have learnt each week. We would be grateful if you could support and encourage your child to return their weekly homework.

Homework will be set on a **Friday** and must be completed and returned on a **Wednesday**.

For children unable to access the internet, paper copies are always available - parents must inform class teacher if these are required.

Homework activities:

- 15 minute daily arithmetic practice using NumBots
- 15 minutes per day home reading and spellings for Phonics
- Your child may be provided with additional homework, where necessary.

Reading at home

Reading records are sent home on a Friday and must be returned to school Wednesday of the following week. **Your child is encouraged to read at least three times a week with an adult, who should then comment and sign the reading record on each of the three occasions.**

Children who read at least three times per week will be awarded a Golden Ticket. Every time your child earns a Golden Ticket, their name is entered into a monthly draw to win a new reading book and certificate.

Please encourage your child to read as regularly as possible.

PE

Your child's PE day for **Summer 2** is **Wednesday**.

All pupils must wear a **school PE kit** which consists of a red crew neck t-shirt & black shorts or black joggers. *Please make sure that shorts are knee length or slightly above.*
