Nursery



This term our theme within the Early Years is Amazing Me

In Nursery our topic is My Home and My Family

The children will settle into Nursery by playing and exploring and making new friends. They will develop a sense of belonging by learning our Hello and Goodbye song, taking part in our routine and making relationships with their teachers and friends. The children will further develop a sense of themselves by exploring their own feelings and the feelings of others.

Through the topic of 'My Home and Family' the children will learn about where they live and their wider family, learning about their own life story and family history. The children will continue to develop their understanding of themselves and their history and family by exploring their family tree, creating a 'My History' book and learning about where they live and belong. The children will find out about other children and families from around the world through developing a partnership and communication with a Nursery from another country celebrating the similarities and differences between themselves and families around the world.

Ideas to support your child's learning through this topic:

Communication and Language

- Talk to your child about what you can see on your journey from and to school
- Talk about your family and extended family

Physical Development

- Develop your child's self-care skills such as washing and drying their own hands and going to the toilet
- Encourage your child to put on their own coat

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Encourage your child to take turns with their toys
- Encourage your child to understand feelings they are having through naming them "I can see that you are feeling..."

Literacy

- Encourage your child to draw pictures, encouraging them to talk about what they have drawn
- Read lots of stories with your child

Maths

- Count actions with your child such as steps, claps, jumps
- Sing number rhymes with your child

Understanding the World

- Talk about your family and who is special to your child
- Explore outside and how things change in Autumn

Expressive Arts and Design

- Create models of your house using recyclable materials
- Encourage your child to draw pictures of your family or your house
